The physical impact of living with a bleeding disorder is well cited, but it is only in recent years that the mental and psychological impacts are not as evident until we look into some factors on a deeper level. As with many other chronic illnesses, those that are impacted by bleeding disorders can also suffer from mental health disorders such as depression, anxiety, attention deficit disorder, and other general mental health disorders. We know that children, adolescents, and the adult populations with bleeding disorders are at risk for symptoms of mental health indicators and it is important to know there is support for both the physical impact of bleeding disorders on an individual as well as the risk of mental health indicators.

Obtaining the appropriate mental health or psychological support is important as there are services to help improve any emotional or mental health challenge. May is Mental Health month, so be aware there is professional support and guidance for anyone in need.

WHAT: Pre-Camp Meeting (Please bring/know your child's social security number)

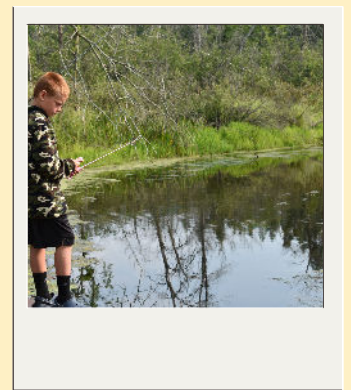
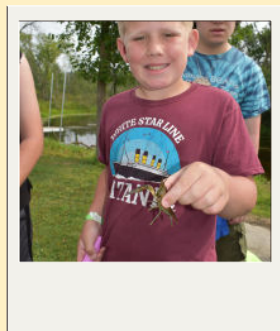
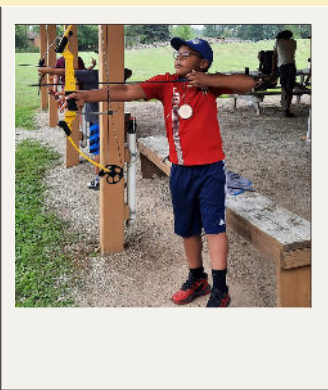
