2025 Open Enrollment

There are a few questions you need to ask when choosing an insurance plan if you or a family member have a bleeding disorder diagnosis.

- ·How do you get your insurance? (Employer sponsored plan, Marketplace, public payer such as Medicare or Medicaid, currently uninsured, etc.)
- ·Is your preferred pharmacy in network (including your HTC's Pharmacy)?
- ·Are your/your family members medications covered?
- Does manufacturer copay assistance count toward your deductible or max out of pocket?
- ·Ensure you have appropriate coverage (If health insurance is obtained via the marketplace)

Open Enrollment Season is approaching again! If you have concerns about any of the questions listed above, we invite you to contact HOC to speak to the Business Office as everyone's health insurance circumstances will vary. REMEMBER...

> While HOC cannot make the decision for you, we are dedicated to providing you with the education and resources you need to choose the best plan for your unique needs. It's crucial to keep HOC informed about any changes to your insurance so we can ensure there are no gaps in your treatment plan or that of your family members. Butternut Squash Soup

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 3 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 medium butternut squash (about 3 pounds), peeled and cubed
- 4 cups vegetable broth
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 cup heavy whipping cream
- Optional: Additional heavy whipping cream and crispy sage leaves

- 1. In a large saucepan, heat oil over medium heat. Add onion; cook until tender. Add garlic; cook one minute longer.
- 2. Stir in squash, broth, salt and pepper; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; simmer, covered, 10-15 minutes or until squash is tender. Puree soup using an immersion blender, or cool slightly and puree soup in batches in a blender; return to pan. Add cream; cook and stir until heated through. If desired, garnish with additional heavy whipping cream and crispy sage.
