#### **HOC** has some exciting changes coming in 2025!

- **The Family Meeting:** HOC's newsletter will come to you quarterly starting in 2025, instead of monthly. No worries, if there is anything we need to get to our community immediately, we will send you communication through email or postal mail.
- Social Work: We are excited to announce that Heather, our former Program/Communications Coordinator, will now serve as HOC's Certified Social Worker. With years of experience in social work, she will help guide patients to critical resources and will be conducting both pediatric and adult assessments. Heather will work alongside Joe, our Behavioral Health Specialist, who will focus on expanding counseling services to continue meeting patient and family needs.
- Physical Therapy Services: Starting in January 2025, we are restructuring our physical therapy services to offer more personalized and effective treatments. Our new PT visits may entail a previsit assessment conducted via phone, followed by a more individualized follow-up plan to ensure the best outcomes for each patient. We are committed to ensuring a smooth transition and maintaining the highest quality care. We would also like to acknowledge Charity and Shanie, whose years of service have made a significant impact on our community. We are grateful for their time and dedication to serving this community as we embrace this new chapter.
- Comprehensive Care Appointments: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we offered limited care options, allowing you to see only select staff. Research shows that patients benefit from engaging with the full care team. Starting in 2025, all patients will be required to meet with the entire team during comprehensive care visits, which will last approximately 2 hours. If this time frame is not convenient, please reschedule to ensure you receive all necessary services.
- Additional Comprehensive Clinic Appointment Dates and Availability: We are excited to
  announce that we have added 12 additional clinic dates to accommodate your needs. To schedule
  your next comprehensive appointment, please contact our office at your earliest convenience. We
  are excited to offer additional days of the week and look forward to seeing you soon!
- **HOC Programs**: We are streamlining our programs to focus on a select few high-impact initiatives that will provide more meaningful support. This year, we will pilot an innovative education program, and your feedback will be crucial in shaping and improving future offerings.
